

Guideline for Marshalls -2017

1. The Harwich Guy Carnival will; take place on :-
2. Saturday 29th October 2017 commencing at 6-30 sharp
The procession will form up in the main road Tollgate between the junction of Oakley road and Ainger road. It will travel the entire length of the main road. High street Main road and west street A break at "ASDA" for approx. 15 mins will happen and the finally into west street with the lead float stopping if long enough at the junction of West street and the Quay Harwich. Prize giving will take place outside "Cutaway Barbers" in west street Prior too dispersal
A road closer order has been obtained for the entire length on a rolling road basis
3. The Essex Police will not provide any officers to oversee the procession and will only be available as crime prevention basis
4. It is necessary for marshals; to assist in the safe passage of the procession through the town by stopping motorised vehicles from being trapped within the procession or sending them into the path of the event
5. The primary object of the evening will be a **SAFE EVENT FOR ALL TO ENJOY** whilst allowing some high spirits and it is this objective that all our attention should be directed to.
6. As in previous Years guidelines include:-
 - a. **No inebriated persons to be on floats**
 - b. **No getting on or off floats whilst in motion or at a non-agreed stop**
 - c. **No persons on floats when at dispersing**
 - d. **Drivers to remain in their vehicles at all times**
 - e. **No buckets to be allowed on floats for collecting Float organisers can have participants walking along side their respective floats collecting money in secured authorised Buckets**
7. Florissant tabards will be available for collecting by all marshals from the forecourt of Chase Lane stores from 5-30 onwards all marshals shall wear their given tabard at all times for safety and identification, these will be returned at the end of the carnival in West street
8. All Rotarians not engaged in traffic diversions or other appointed duty MUST escort the

There should be at least one Rotarian each side of every tableau

Attention must be paid to the guidelines detailed above and any breach dealt with.

Each Tableau Organiser will have been made aware of their responsibility.
